I have very concerned that in your screening of applicants, not ONE SINGLE candidate from a rural area was included. There is some bias in the questions/answers or process, even if it is unintended. Hopefully this will be repaired next time around. If you look at your map, Region 9 is close to 45% of the state geographically, which means your wonderful redistricting for a good half of this rural state had ZERO representation and input. Your most northern meeting seems to be in Fresno (9 hours drive) or the Bay area, (7 to 8 hours drive). Couldn't you even stir your stumps to get up to Redding? (A mere 2.75 hour drive from Modoc).

Please repair your bias for the next redistricting in 10 years.
