
Dear Ms. Dai and Peter Yao:

Dear Commissioners:

On behalf of the Morongo Band of Mission Indians, I am writing to express our appreciation for the hard work of the Commission in its efforts to reapportion California's congressional districts. Additionally, I would ask the members of the Commission maintain its earlier decision to keep Riverside and Imperial counties in separate congressional districts.

Given the strong economic and civic commonality of interest within the county and the significant number of tribes engaged in large scale economic development ventures, it would be to the benefit of Riverside County residents, including the members of the Morongo Band of Mission Indians, if their congressional representation were not split between two geographically large counties with less commonality of interest. From economic development, to tourism, to transportation concerns, the people of Riverside County maintain a level of continuity that would not likely be shared with communities that make up Imperial County. Such a conflict between the needs of the two counties would likely greatly diminish the ability of any representative to fight for the needs of their constituents and alternatives should be embraced.

I look forward to working with the members of this Commission to address any questions you may have regarding the concerns of the Morongo Band of Mission Indians.
