Honorable Members of the California Citizens Redistricting Commission:

Prior to the release of the most recent statewide visualization district maps, by your commission, on July 19, 2011, we provided public input to the first round of draft district maps on May 26, 2011. Since then, we have been following the process and have modified our priorities. Please find Camarillo's priorities in the order depicted below for your consideration:

Priority 1

With respect to one of CCRC's criteria, maintaining political subdivision boundaries, the City of Camarillo desires to be kept whole.

Priority 2

Ventura County remain a whole district and not separated into different districts. In terms of governmental services, environmental custodians, infrastructure, economic development, housing, transportation, land use, charitable services, and service organizations, Ventura County traditionally functions as a regional unit. Camarillo considers Ventura County an entity comprised of the county of Ventura and ten cities which serve the best interest of their residents.

Priority 3

In order to ensure that the City of Camarillo's unique characteristics, as stated above, remain intact, we encourage the CCRC to keep the City of Camarillo out of any Los Angeles County Districts.

We greatly appreciate your commitment to ensuring a fair and transparent redistricting process here in California.
