This message is to register my opposition to the current plan to partition the city of Richmond into separate Congressional districts and absorb the city of San Pablo into the 10th district. This would put Richmond, a large community of almost 100, 000 in competition for scarce funds, double the effort of local elected officials as they work with two different representatives who may have other priorities in terms of what is good for our city. In addition, the urban, minority-population city of San Pablo has far more in common with Richmond than it does w/ East County communities.
