Subject: Redistricting - Keep Marin and SF separate

Message Body:

I STRONGLY URGE you to keep Marin/Sonoma/Northcoast SEPARATE from San Francisco. The former are uburban/rural counties and do not have a commonality of interest with SF. When SF is in the mix, Marin/Sonoma has been overshadowed by SF (e.g., state senate). As a 24 year homeowner in Marin (and 14 years in SF before that) I URGE putting Marin and all of Sonoma together in the various districts (including Santa Rosa), rather than splitting Sonoma County.

If this is not possible, I urge you to use the first draft, i.e., a Marin/Sonoma /Northcoast counties configuration. Thank you.
