Subject: Congressional lines in San Francisco

Dear Commissioners:

I appreciate being given two minutes to remark on general items at 6:00 yesterday at your meeting. I wanted to revise and extend my remarks on one matter.

Regarding the latest Congressional visualization you will be considering regarding San Francisco, I discussed the lines with Supervisor Sean Elsbernd (District 7 -- which covers the West of Twin Peaks neighborhoods, Park Merced, and other neighborhoods in western San Francisco and George Wooding the President of the West of Twin Peaks Council. Both objected to the division of the West of Twin Peaks neighborhoods by the visualization. They want all of the neighborhoods (17 in toto) to be kept as a unit, either in District 08 or 12. Again, the CCAG proposal we submitted yesterday does that by putting all of the West of Twin Peaks neighborhoods into CD08, and including all of Supervisorial District 11, as well as the Portola district (in both Districts 9 & 10) into CD12.
