Greetings,

Siskiyou County as a whole is bound by family, history, employment, resources, common culture, common majority experience and accessible geographic boundaries. Our county is intrinsically tied with other counties having the same socio-economic backgrounds within the current districting boundaries and reasonably accessible physical proximity proving fair representation. To incorporate Siskiyou County, in whole or in part, within a coastal district that is far less physically accessible and politically diametrically opposed will create immense difficulties in representation and county function. Isolating Siskiyou County, in whole or part, and placing them within a district in which we cannot reasonably participate effectively subjugates us personally to inequitable and inaccessible representation.

Please do not place our county in such a position through coastal district inclusion that will promote animosity, discord, and unequal representation and access for so many years to come. Our beloved region already suffers enough difficulties without that added travesty.

Dear Committee Members:

This letter is to express strong opposition to grouping Scott Valley and the rest of Western Siskiyou County in with the Del Norte-Mendocino and North Coast Districts. This change would lead to an unjust and unacceptable loss of representation for the citizens of Western Siskiyou County, the vast majority of whom do not share economic, social, cultural, or political values or interests with the cities, counties, or neighborhoods of the North Coast -- all of which are at least a four-hour drive away!

The redistricting law stipulates that the " geographical integrity of any city, county, or neighborhood shall be respected." In the spirit of the law, Western Siskiyou County should stay within Assembly District 2, Senate District 4, and Congressional District 2.

I am one of many Scott Valley residents who urge the committee to slow down and give this issue the time and careful consideration it deserves.
