Dear Commission members,

With the coming budget cuts, Trinity County is going to need more of a cooperative relationship with nearby Shasta County in order to keep providing services to its residents. With a tax base of only 14,000 residents, no way is this county going to maintain its jail. It's going to have to contract with nearby Shasta county in Redding sooner or later.

The quest of join with the coast for a congressional seat is around one issue only—water. It makes no practical sense in terms of local government. Governmentally speaking, the immediate needs of this county and its residents are for services from nearby Shasta County. It makes no sense whatsoever to join it with a coast county in my opinion.
