





Community is a strong sense of who we are. Torrance is the heart of the Beach Cities/South Bay. The big mall/entertainment area pulls from the beach cities and Palos Verdes. It is clearly physically adjacent to us in Palos Verdes and I drive through it daily and shop/ dine there weekly.
