Thank you very much for your service to this Commission, and all your hard work on the numerous district maps. I have had the opportunity to view the preliminary maps for both the 50th (MMRHB) and 52nd (NESAN) Congressional districts that have been presented by the Commission.

In the preliminary final Congressional maps, the district labeled 52 (MMRHB), which includes the City of Poway, part of the City of San Diego, and the City of Coronado. The other district labeled 50 (NESAN) which includes the City of San Marcos, the City of Escondido, and much of the east County of San Diego. Anticipating that both Members of Congress continue to serve these areas, I respectfully request that the district numbering of these two areas be exchanged with each other, which is more consistent with what they are currently.


This would be extremely helpful for many functional and financial reasons. Both offices have many items which incorporate usage of our district numbers
