On behalf of the City of Cypress, I am writing to bring to your attention the City's concerns in regard to the preliminary final maps set for final consideration and adoption on August 15, 2011.

As the process moves forward, there have been several different proposals considered for the northern area of Orange County. We believe that the City would be best served by being in a congressional district with other Northern Orange County cities. The City has relationship and collaborations with our neighbors on issues impacting our region, such as regional transportation planning. The current draft map places Cypress in a district with the City of Long Beach, the only non-Orange County city in the proposed district and is the largest in geographic area. Our concern is that due to its size, the needs of Long Beach, such as service needs related to the Port of Long Beach would supersede the interest of other smaller cities in the district, all of which are located in Orange County.

Concurrently, the City of Cypress shares the same concern with the proposed State Senate Redistricting Map. This proposed map places the City of Cypress in a district with cities from three different counties: Los Angeles, Orange, and San Bernardino. The cities proposed for the district differ in service needs due to varying characteristics and different issues across county lines. Again, we believe the City of Cypress would be best served in a Senate district with other Orange County cities.

We urge you to carefully consider the placement of Cypress in districts that are comprised of other Orange County cities in keeping with one of the Commission's principles to keep city and county boundaries intact. Thank you for your time and consideration.
