The KINGS Congressional District contains parts of Bakersfield, while the KR Congressional district contains Rosedale. This was also the case in the 2000 redistricting. Why hasn't that changed? It seems like as much of Bakersfield as possible should be together, and it should certainly be possible to find ~15,000 people on the other side of the line in Bakersfield. Certainly while KINGS is largely rural and so neither Bakersfield nor Rosedale particularly belong, it seems Rosedale is a bit closer to, Hanford (otherwise the largest city in the district), than parts of eastern Bakersfield are.
