While I am uncertain where this currently is in the process, do we understand correctly that you are attempting to take Torrance out of the Beach Cities Assembly District and put it in with Inglewood and Gardena and part of South Central LA.? And that the Congressional District which goes from San Pedro through PV, the Beach Cities - except Torrance - bypasses LAX on Dockweiler Beach before it picks up Santa Monica, Malibu, Bel Air and Beverly Hills? This is one of the worst examples of gerrymandering districts -- and for what real purpose?

Torrance has beach and should clearly remain as part of the Beach Cities Assembly District.

*Put Torrance back in the Beach Cities Assembly District and put the Beach Cities Congressional District back together starting with Westchester and ending with PV or San Pedro. The Congressional District should include Westchester, El Segundo, Hawthorne, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, **all of Torrance**, the Palos Verdes Peninsula, Lomita, Harbor City, San Pedro and as much of Wilmington as possible.*
