Dear CCRC,

The commission is once again in violation of Bagley-Keene. Less than 24 yours before you meet, there is no meaningful agenda posted for the August 7, 2011 hearing, only the boilerplate agenda that offers the public no information on what you will really be discussing and acting on.

I was told by staff at the last hearing on August 9 that you had a 72, 48, 24 hour policy on posting the REAL agendas. This internal policy is itself a violation of Bagley Keene, and intolerable if you can't even manage to live up to it.

This will definitely be an issue in lawsuits. I would respectfully ask you to IMMEDIATELY begin posting real agendas per Bagley-Keene. The boilerplate agenda dodge is illegal as many citizens have pointed out in many letters to this commission.
