
KEEP THE SOUTH BAY TOGETHER!**Dear Re-Districting Committee-**

I understand that there are several proposals being considered with regard to how the new district lines will be drawn. I am hoping that some semblance of common sense will prevail as the City of Torrance is a 'Beach City' and should remain so, and not be split! My wife and I were just at Torrance Beach on July 4th. We know it's still there, and our fine city belongs in a 'beach city' district.

It is our opinion, which I've learned is shared by many others, that the district should include all the beach cities from El Segundo to the south, including the cities located on the Palos Verdes Peninsula. That would cover the area from the 105 Freeway south, and from the Harbor (110) Freeway west. That would make your drawing very simple... Two lines, one on the north and one of the east, and you have an ocean to enclose the west and south sides (which I believe may be part of your Option 1.2). As an appraiser for over 26 years, I know the Los Angeles Basin and Beach areas very well (it's my job!). Hence, Torrance shouldn't be split; Santa Monica, the Palisades, Brentwood, and Malibu belong in their own district to the north; and the City of Hawthorne does NOT belong lumped in with the City of Compton!
