Dear Mr. Claypool:

In the August 22 Teleconference, there was a discussion about whether to continue posting on the web site the communications from the public. There seemed to be a consensus that it would be useful but that there wasn't enough staff time to keep doing it. If the Commission still feels that there is value in posting and the work wouldn't exceed what a semi-competent volunteer could accomplish in 20, or so, hours per week, I am willing to be that volunteer.
