Facsimile copies of ballots in the applicable language are required.

Non-English Languages included in the COI Tool: Spanish, Mandarin (Chinese), Cantonese (Chinese), Tagalog, Armenian, Persian/Farsi, Punjabi, Japanese, Vietnamese, Korean, Arabic, Khmer (Cambodian), Russian

(A) Recommend contracting statewide for translation/interpreter services for the following non-English languages: Chinese (Mandarin/Cantonese), Spanish, Tagalog, and Vietnamese.

(B) Recommend contracting for area-specific translation/interpreter services for the following non-English languages: Arabic, Armenian, Cambodian, Hmong, Japanese, Korean, American Indian, Punjabi, Persian, Syriac, and Thai. For the American Indian languages, we need to confirm with the Native American community regarding translation needs.

(C) Recommend working with local communities to provide area specific translation services for the remaining languages as needed.
