*Note: We have an assumption that a more permanent support system (i.e., not USDR) will need to be hired through Aug/Sept for CRC data management to be successful*

		<b>Pros</b>	<b>Cons</b>
<b>1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• USDR builds out data collection, management, analysis, and publishing</li><li>• CRC hires data analyst (USDR helps)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Start building sooner rather than later</li><li>• Analyst role becomes less broad; candidate pool increases</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hired analyst is locked into technology we choose (e.g., Airtable, Tableau, or Other)</li></ul>
<b>2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• CRC hires data analyst (USDR helps) who builds out data collection, management, analysis and publishing</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hired analyst can choose appropriate technology that they are well versed in</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Start building later</li><li>• Analyst role is broad (consider multiple roles or an agency)</li></ul>
