Every ten years, after the U.S. Census, California must redraw the boundaries of its Congressional, State Senate, State Assembly, and State Board of Equalization districts to reflect the new population data. The Voters FIRST Act (2008) gave this power to the people of California with the creation of the California Citizens Redistricting Commission (Commission). The independent Commission is committed to drawing fair districts that reflect the best interests of the people, not the incumbent politicians.

Through this document, you can make sure the Commission knows about your community by telling the Commission what is important to you, drawing a map of your community, and submitting your community feedback directly to the Commission.
